

CHECK YOUR ELIGIBILITY FOR CANADA: BASIC CHECKLIST

AGE

- Are you 18 years old or older?

EDUCATION

- Have you completed a high school diploma or an equivalent program?
- Do you have any post-secondary education or training?

WORK EXPERIENCE

- Have you worked for at least one year in a skilled occupation?
- Does your work experience match with any of the National Occupational Classification (NOC) codes for Canadian jobs?

LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY

- Can you speak, listen, read, and write in English or French?
- Have you taken a language test (IELTS or CELPIP for English or TEF for French)?

FINANCIAL RESOURCES

- Do you have at least \$3,000 for yourself and any dependents during your stay in Canada?

MEDICAL AND CRIMINAL BACKGROUND

- Are you in good health?
- Do you have a clean criminal record?



If you answered “yes” to most of these questions, you may be eligible to apply for Canadian immigration programs. **Discover the programs and pathways fit for you.**
